Trisha began dancing at age six at the San Jose School of Scottish Dancing under the direction of Norine Harmon. During her competitive career, she was the winner of eleven championship titles and was a finalist to the United States Inter-Regional Highland Dancing Championship thirteen times, finishing in the top six ten times. Trisha is a Fellow of the Scottish Dance Teacher's Alliance.

Trisha received her doctorate in physical therapy from Duke University in 2010 and now holds her Orthopedic Certified Specialist credential. She currently resides with her husband Drew, a bagpiper and US Coast Guard helicopter pilot, in North Bend, Oregon, where she practices as a physical therapist in an outpatient orthopedic and sports clinic.

RULES

- S.O.B.H.D. rules will be followed.
- All dancers must be registered with FUSTA, ScotDance, or SOBHD worldwide, and present their 2014 registration card on day of the competition.
- Dancers who are registered for 2014, but do not have their valid card with them, may dance. However, all dancers without cards must send a copy of their card within 10 days following the competition. Any awards won will be held until the dancer sends a copy of their card to the organizer.
- Age groups will be determined after entries are received.
- Last to enter, first to dance rules apply.
- Organizer reserves the right to combine, split, or delete age groups the day of the competition.
- The organizer reserves the right to make changes to any information and times given in the entry form if necessary.
- Communication by a dancer or parent of a dancer with the judge or piper is not allowed and is grounds for disqualification.
- All winners must be in competition dress to accept awards.
- All dance competitors and teachers are expected to comply with the FUSTA Code of Ethics.
- Cash awards for Premier 16&Over will be \$30, \$25, \$20.
- Special Celtic Christmas Choreography
- 16 & Over \$60, \$40, \$20. 15 & Under \$30, \$20, \$10.
- Most Promising Pre-Premier to receive \$25-To be selected by the Judge.
- Judge's decision is final. Any protest must be in writing, signed, and handed to the organizer by the end of the competition, accompanied by a \$30 fee that will be refundable if the protest is sustained.
- \$2 of each entry will go to FUSTA.
- This is a non-refundable entry fee.
- All dances count towards the aggregate trophy with the exception of the Celtic Christmas Choreography.
